At least you have half a chance of catching these Beavers - providing the Museum is not closed !












I think we all recognise this airframe ? **CF-FHB (1)** preserved at our National Aviation Museum in Ottawa.

CF-OBS (2) in action, she can now be seen on display at the Bushplane Heritage Museum in Sault Ste Marie.




Here CF-OBS is on a test flight many years ago

52-6087 (454) Robins Air Force Base - Museum of Aviation, Robins AFB., Warner-Robins, Georgia.




52-6135 (525) was at Clearwater, Florida, but I'm uncertain where she is now, perhaps Wauchula Airport.

8018 (875) at the Military Museum of the Chinese People's revolution, Beijing. Chung-Kuo Kung Chuan / Taiwan AF • Landed on a beach in Fujian, China, u/c collapsed 22/04/83 - Aircraft defected from Formosa / Taiwan, piloted by Maj Li Dawei.

S-6 (959) currently in store with the Dutch Military at Soesterberg AFB.







Very active in the air show circuit in the Netherlands is **S-9 (965)** which is actually **PH-DHC**.



56-0367 (1062) looking rather "stiff" at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. On loan from Fort Rucker to 45th Infantry Division Museum.

XP820 (1483) the AAC Museum's active Beaver. This fine example performs at Air Shows and other events around the United Kingdom.



XP821 (1484) in Middle Wallop Museum.

XP822 (1486) Middle Wallop gate guard for the Army Aviation Museum since 1987.



C-FMAA (1500) · Last flown 1985 - now resides in Western Canada Museum at Winnipeg Airport, Manitoba.



P-05 (1506) is now kept inside at Museo Nacional de Aeronautica, Moron - Buenos Aires, Argentina.
